## Individual Program

You can obtain this certificate by **completing an individual program**, containing courses as well as **the following elements:**

- \* Teaching Portfolio (approx. 25 SU)
- \* Teaching Project (15 - 35 SU)
- \* Teaching Observation & Consultation in the context of the Teaching Project (at least 4 SU)
- \* Peer Observation (at least 4 SU)

Study units conducted within the advanced level certificate count toward the specialization level certificate.

**Advanced Level**  
min. 120 SU

## Courses in our Higher Education Teaching Program

You can obtain this certificate by attending **basic and advanced level courses totalling a minimum of 120 SU** from the following topic areas, including at least **1 Teaching Observation & Consultation** and **1 Peer Observation** (each 4 SU) :

- \* Theories of Teaching & Learning [A] at least 25 SU basic or advanced level courses
- \* Presentation & Communication [B] at least 25 SU basic or advanced level courses
- \* Assessment [C] at least 10 SU basic or advanced level courses
- \* Reflection & Evaluation [D] at least 25 SU basic or advanced level courses
- \* Advising & Counseling [E] at least 10 SU basic or advanced level courses

Study units conducted within the basic level certificate count toward the advanced level certificate.

**Foundation Level**  
min. 60 SU

## Courses in our Higher Education Teaching Program

You can obtain this certificate by attending the **foundation course that totals 60 SU in five different** topic areas:

- \* Theories of Teaching & Learning [A]
- \* Presentation & Communication [B]
- \* Assessment [C]
- \* Reflection & Evaluation [D]
- \* Advising & Counseling [E]

One **study unit (SU)** equals 45 minutes. If you attended Higher Education Teaching Courses which have been conducted within the ProfiLehrePlus-network, these can be counted towards the certificate if they do not date back more than 6 years.
